Stayers on the Flat

I am revisiting an article I wrote a couple of years ago regarding trainers that excel with their stayers on the flat and on the all-weather (AW). The reason for that is two-fold.

Firstly, the trainers I highlighted did well and made me a few quid, and, secondly I have had another 2 years to hone my skills at mining data from Horse Race Base and it is well worth applying the knowledge I have gained in recent years to a system that worked quite well last time.

As regular readers are well aware, I am a jumps fan more than a flat racing fan but as a tipster you have to cover both codes. Of all the types of flat racing, the staying races are the ones I prefer to bet on. It may simply be a case of getting more for your money's worth as the races obviously take longer to complete.

For some unknown reason I also seem to be better at picking winners in races of 1m 4f upwards compared to sprint races, mile races and those other middle distances shy of a mile and a half. The other thing I like about staying races is that hard luck stories such as draw bias, traffic problems and interference do not have the same profound effect that they can have in races up to a mile.

In a sprint race, your bet can be over within the first few seconds if your fancy is slow out of the gate or stumbles leaving the stalls. That is one of the most frustrating sights to a punter.

Such slowly away or clumsy types in staying races, however, have plenty of time to recover. Another frustrating sight is seeing your fancy fly home after being left with too much to do or failing to get a run at a crucial time.

Again, over longer distances there is plenty of time to come from off the pace or eventually get a run even if the horse is checked a couple of times.

So, rant over, and on to Horse Race Base.

I have looked at all races run over distances of 1m 5f and upwards on the flat and AW in both the UK and Ireland since 2010. As always, it is the trainers I am after for my notebook and the conditions or particular type of horse to follow.

I am not necessarily looking purely on profit but looking for a good strike rate, a respectable return on investment and consistency.

The latter is one of the pitfalls of system creation.

Always eyeball the results to look for consistency rather than a hit and miss profile. I am conscious that the flat season may well be over by the time you read this, so I have included plenty of AW action to see us through until next year.

So, these are the trainers that have gone into my tracker for the next 12 months and the conditions to note when they send out runners over staying trips.

Mark Johnston

Mark Johnston is almost impossible to get a read on. His horses run a blinder, then flop, then bounce back when you least expect it. One thing is a given though, his horses are tough, especially the stayers. What we need to do however is head over to the AW to find some decent profits.

Above you will see Mark Johnston's record with horses racing on the AW over trips of 1m 5f or further.

His 10-year strike rate is 24% and the P/L at Betfair SP is £111.74 to £1 level stakes.

What really impresses me however is that ROI of 46%.

For every £100 staked you would have returned £145.99. I could simply leave it there, but it is well worth exploring the data a little more.

First, we find that Newcastle, the UK's newest AW racecourse if you like, is not a happy hunting ground with just 2 winners from 26 runners. I think it is safe to eliminate that one.

His Southwell record is in decline with fewer runners and fewer winners so that course can go too.

Next up is race class. The trainer is 0-2 in Class 1, 0-1 in Class 7 and although he has a 29% strike rate at Class 6 level, these runners show an overall loss. So, I am sticking to Class 2 down to Class 5 races.

All but four winners have come in races with 5 to 13 runners.

Winners have come in handicap and non-handicap races and the age of the horse has no real bearing on its chances of winning.

I am going to leave it there as other filters I have explored such as the number of runs in the season, career runs, career wins and previous track form do not make any difference to the overall outcome, the results of which are shown below:

We have lost a few winners along the way by adding in our filters, but we now see an ROI just south of 100%. The strike rate is a respectable 27% and we should get around 12 to 15 bets a year.

System 73: Mark Johnston runners at all AW tracks except Southwell and Newcastle, racing at class 2 to class 5 level over 1m 5f or further in fields of 5 to 13 runners.

Willie Mullins

No stranger to success on the flat, Willie Mullins 10-year figures are all the more interesting given he made a loss with such runners in 2010, 2011 and 2012.

His 10-year stats are shown below:

If we concentrate on 2013 to 2019, we see that his 7-year stats are as follows:

When we remove those lean years, we see that his performance has improved markedly in terms of the ROI which has nearly doubled. In fact, he has targeted some of the big staying handicaps at the big flat festivals and also likes a crack at the Cesarewitch, Pitmen's Derby and Ebor to name but just a few of the big prized staying handicaps.

A 20% strike rate is very good given the competitive nature of many of the races he targets.

Over in Ireland there are a number of festivals that he targets, particularly the Galway Festival and the 4-day festivals at Tramore and Killarney. More on that later.

When looking a little deeper into the results we find that he is just 3-23 with horses aged 9yo and older.

So, we will focus on those aged between 3yo and 8yo.

The other thing to note is that all winners had raced no more than 14 times on the flat. That may seem an excessive upper limit, but we are dealing with older horses in the main, and those with more than 14 starts are 0-21.

We can also add to that the fact that all bar one of the Mullins winners had won no more than 4 previous flat starts.

So, we have tweaked a few things, most likely eliminating the older more exposed runners and that leaves us looking at the following set of results for the last 7 years:

What I want to do next is concentrate on those courses where he has a better than average strike rate compared to his strike rate across all the courses where he has sent his flat stayers.

42 of the 51 winners have come at the following courses: Ascot, Ballinrobe, Curragh, Galway, Gowran Park, Killarney, Leopardstown, Listowel and Tramore.

That leaves us looking at the final set of results for our Willie Mullins micro-angle:

This produces a system with a 29% strike rate and an ROI of over 100%.

It will be interesting to see how it goes over the next 12 months as we know Mullins is no flash-in-the-pan and always has good horses in his yard.

System 74: Willie Mullins runners in races over 1m 5f or further, aged 3yo to 8yo, no more than 14 previous flat starts, no more than 4 previous flat wins, racing at Ascot, Ballinrobe, Curragh, Galway, Gowran Park, Killarney, Leopardstown, Listowel and Tramore.

Hughie Morrison

Hughie Morrison made it onto our list last time and he is always one whose runners' interest me over marathon trips.

His bare figures may not seem that spectacular in terms of the number of winners, strike rate and P/L compared to some of the other trainers we will be looking at, but he is my Number One go-to guy in these races because he consistently wins his fair share year-in and year-out. He also tends to target the big prize staying handicaps with a lot of success.

We will begin by looking at his overall record in races over 1m 5f and further both on the flat since 2010.

We see above that he more or less breaks even at Betfair SP (small loss overall).

However, ditching the non-handicap runners has an immediate positive effect:

As you can see, the majority of winners and all of the profits have come in handicap races and we will concentrate on those. Next, we find that he is 2-26 over trips of 1m 5f and 1m 5 ½f. The profits start at 1m 6f.

Perhaps the most telling statistic is that 27 of the 29 winners in 1m6f+ handicaps were aged 3yo or 4yo. The older horses are 2-59 so they are clearly ones to avoid. That nudges his strike rate up to nearly 20%.

If we also factor in the observation that all 27 winners went off at an industry SP of 11/4 to 16/1 and all the profit came in 3yo only and 3yo+ handicaps, we end up with the following set of numbers:

These filters do limit the amount of action in any one year, but the strike rate is 25% and the ROI is well over 100% so it could be well worth the wait for a qualifier or two to come along.

System 75: Hughie Morrison runners aged 3yo or 4yo running in 3yo or 3yo+ handicaps over 1m 6f or further and sent off at industry SP odds of 11/4 to 16/1.

John Gosden

If you want a more straightforward approach, then John Gosden is a master trainer in staying races. His bare figures for the flat (not AW), without any additional filters, are shown below:

He does not run as many as some trainers, particularly the likes of Mark Johnston, but he is operating at a 23% strike rate and you certainly get your money's worth with level stakes profits of £95.51 and a 36% ROI.

It does not seem to matter if he is running them in a handicap or a non-handicap race as you can see below. There is a nice even split between runners in the two types of race and the number of winners, placers, P/L are fairly similar.

It is possible to improve slightly on the bare figures if we strike a line through those races run over further than 2 miles.

His record in these races is not bad (7 winners from 41 runners) but these runners make a small loss so ignoring these races will increase the ROI. In fact, sticking to races between 1m 6f and 2 miles produces an ROI of 47%, which is good in anyone's book.

There is not a lot else to say about John Gosden's stayers other than we can improve the results slightly by sticking to those sent off at an industry SP of 16/1 or shorter.

The one potential micro-angle bubbling under the surface of those impressive results is the tracks where he does best.

Those include Ascot, Doncaster, Haydock, Newmarket's July and Rowley Mile courses, Nottingham (where he sends a lot of his younger runners) and York. Combining those courses gives us the following results:

As you can see, we lose just 8 winners from the system, but we increase the strike rate to close to 30% and the ROI nearly goes through the roof at a high of 92%.

System 78: John Gosden runners in races between 1m 5f and 2 miles, sent off at 16/1 or shorter at Ascot, Doncaster, Haydock, Newmarket's July and Rowley Mile courses, Nottingham and York.

For the start of the Gold members section I want to return to Hughie Morrison and this time take a look at his AW runners:

Hughie Morrison (AW)

The first thing to note is that there is a great deal of similarity between the Hughie Morrison flat and AW stayers in terms of where the profits lie. His record on the AW since 2010 reads:

We are immediately on the front foot with a strike rate in excess of 20% and a decent ROI at Betfair SP.

Like we saw with the Hughie Morrison flat stayers, we need to strike a line through those contesting non-handicap races:

Sticking to the handicappers we find that he is just 4-38 in Class 2, 3 and 4 races and 27-95 in Class 5 and 6 races. Looks like his runners that drop towards the basement level are well worth following.

His runners do particularly well at Southwell (10-27) and Chelmsford City (8-15) but he has had 9 winners in Class 5 and 6 races at the other AW courses.

This time we find his record is best in 3yo+ and 4yo+ handicaps and he does not do so well in 3yo only handicaps. That leaves us with the following results since 2010:

System 79: Hughie Morrison runners in 3yo+ and 4yo+ class 5 and class 6 handicap races on the AW, run over trips of 1m 5f or further.

William Knight

Sticking to the AW and a new trainer for us in William Knight.

He does not have a huge number of runners but the AW is where he makes his profit with his stayers.

As you can see, we are only looking at about 8 to 10 bets a year, but the ROI is impressive.

He does not run many in non-handicap races and these have a record of 0-6.

All 20 winners were racing over 1m 6f to 2m ½f and that improves the figures quite a bit.

18 of those 20 winners were aged between 3yo and 6yo and he has tasted success at all the AW courses.

That leaves a tidy set of figures:

The good news for us is that he is running around a dozen horses under such conditions each year so we should not have to wait too long for the qualifiers.

That number may even increase.

Carlisle Racecourse

In last month's OCP magazine I looked at Kelso racecourse. This month I'm taking the short journey across the border to Carlisle.

As before in this series of articles on British racecourses, I will look briefly at the track's location, history, configuration and will also highlight some significant track stats.

Carlisle racecourse hosts both flat and jumps racing but as we have reached October and the winter jumps season is almost upon us. The track stats will be for National Hunt racing only.

History and Location

The earliest record of racing taking place in the area is 1559, when Lady Dacre presented the historic Carlisle Bell to the winner.

Carlisle Racecourse is in the English County of Cumbria, lying just over 2 miles south of the town of Carlisle. Racing has been taking place on its present site since 1904.

In July 1929 the Totalisator Board (Tote) operated their pool betting system for the first time on a British racecourse at Carlisle.

Back in the 50s and the halcyon days of British horse racing, as a spectator sport, British Rail would run special race day trains from places like Liverpool to Carlisle.

For those coming to the races by car the Racecourse is very easily accessible being located just off the M6 (Junction 42).

Racegoers coming by public transport are also well served. Carlisle Station is on the West Coast Main Line, that runs from London Euston to Glasgow Central and the racecourse provides a bus service from the town centre which also picks up passengers opposite the railway station. The cost of the service at the time of writing is just £2.

The Colin Parker Memorial Chase, held late October/early November, is the highlight of the National Hunt season at Carlisle.

The 2m ½ f chase affair often attracts good horses.

Previous winners of the race include the likes of Tidal Bay, Monet's Garden and future Grand National Winner Many Clouds won the 2014 renewal on his seasonal debut before going on to win the Hennessey Gold Cup at Newbury.

Track Configuration

National Hunt racing takes place throughout the winter at Carlisle.

The course is 1m 5f in circumference and right-handed. The last half mile in the straight provides a steep incline.

During the winter the going can become heavy which combined with the courses stiff uphill finish provides a real stamina test for both horse and jockey.

When the going is heavy you will often see jockeys bring their horses over to the stand side in search of better ground.

Most horsemen would consider Carlisle to be a fair and galloping track. The fences are not the most difficult to jump although novices can be caught out.

The first fence in the home straight (see link below) can be a tricky one as horses run downhill to it after the bend.

Carlisle Stats: National Hunt

As ever let's begin by looking at some general stats including favourite stats at the course since 2015.

The stats below are from Jan 1st, 2015 to the time of writing (10/09/19) and cover all jump meetings at the course.

Once again, I am using the ever useful www.horseracebase.com for the stats.

Let's begin by looking at some general meeting stats from the last five years. Beginning with the fate of the favourites both clear and joint.

The results below contain 361 winners from 2916 runners 889 placed.

Favourites

Clear favourites have produced the following set of results:

- **133 winners from 335 runners 37% -40.82 A/E 0.9 205 placed 61%.**

Breaking those results down into handicap & non-handicap races gives us:

- **Non-handicap – 66 winners from 137 runners 48% -14.2 A/E 0.93 98 placed 72%.**
- **Handicaps – 57 winners from 198 runners 295 -26.62 A/E 0.86 107 placed 54%.**

Digging a bit deeper let's focus on favourites that won their last race and those favourites who had finished outside the first three on their last start.

- **Favourites that won their last race have produced – 49 winners from 95 runners 52% +12.43 A/E 1.15 67 placed 71%.**
- **Favourites that had finished outside the top four on their last start produced – 37 winners from 118 runners 31% -16.67 A/E 0.81 69 placed 58%.**

Summary: Clear favourites who won last time out have an excellent win strike rate.

Trainers and Favourites

If you're a favourite backer. Here are the best performing trainers when the money is down:

- **Stuart Crawford – 7 winners from 9 runners 78% +5.3 A/E 1.59 8 placed 89%.**
- **Jennie Candlish - 3 winners from 5 runners 60% +5.01 A/E 1.66 4 placed 80%.**
- **Nigel Hawke – 4 winners from 7 runners 57% +3 A/E 1.88 6 placed 86%.**
- **Venetia Williams – 5 winners from 10 runners 50% +1.16 A/E 1.1 6 placed 60%.**
- **Brian Ellison – 5 winners from 10 runners 50% -0.12 A/E 1.07 8 placed 80%.**

Summary: Trainers whose clear favourites are worth noting are Stuart Crawford, Nigel Hawke and Jennie Candlish.

Jockeys and Favourites

Which jockeys have done the business when the money is down for favourite backers?

- **Sam Twiston-Davies – 8 winners from 13 runners 62% +8.02 A/E 1.35 9 placed 69%.**
- **Sean Quinlan – 6 winners from 10 runners 60% +8.59 A/E 1.73 8 placed 80%.**
- **Ross Chapman - 3 winners from 4 runners 75% +3.82 A/E 1.79.**
- **Ciaran Gethings – 2 winners from 2 runners 100% + 3.33 A/E 2.38.**
- **Lucy Alexander – 2 winners from 2 runners 100% + 3.08 A/E 2.5.**
- **Charlie Deutsch – 2 winners from 2 runners 100% + 2.38 A/E 1.68.**

Summary: Jockey's to note on clear favourites are Sam Twiston-Davies & Sean Quinlan

General Course Stats

- **Odds SP: 18/1 & above – 12 winners from 850 runners 1% -526 61 placed 7% A/E 0.54.**

Summary: Big priced winners 18/1 and above do occasionally win at Carlisle but they are few and far between and it's not really a winner finding pond you want to be fishing in.

- **Previous course winners provided 65 winners from 417 runners 16% -54.43 A/E 0.89 161 placed 39%.**

Summary: Previous course winners are performing about average at Carlisle, so it isn't really a course specialist's track.

Trainer Stats and Angles

Here are a few interesting trainer track stats. That will hopefully enable you to identify some winners at Carlisle, throughout the rest of the 2019-20 National Hunt season.

Nigel Hawke – 4 winners from 9 runners 44% +10.88 A/E 2.47 A/E 6 placed 67%.

Nicky Richards – 8 winners from 23 runners 35% +37.5 A/E 1.97 11 placed 48%.

2. Trainers & Handicap Chase Runners (16/1 & under).

Jennie Candlish – 7 winners from 19 runners 37% +18.13 A/E 2.39 11 placed 58%.

3. Trainers & Race Class – Handicaps (16/1 & under).

Nicky Richards (Class 2) - 4 winners from 9 runners 44% +32.5 A/E 3.17 5 placed 56%.

Q and A James Walsh Tipster Empire

Hi James, and many thanks for joining us this month, first off would you start by telling our readers a little about yourself and your background?

My name is James Walsh and my journey into the tipping game began nearly 12 years ago when I set up www.jpwracingtipster.com

I was making good profits on my own and always giving out my tips to my friends. I found that although making profit was a good thing, tipping winners to friends gave me greater satisfaction.

I suppose professional gambling can be quite lonely at times and I preferred the interaction with friends each day with the tipping side of the game, so decided to become a tipster rather than a lone gambler.

Over the next 8 years I made a decent name for myself as a tipster especially when it came to National Hunt Racing. We are now going into our 12th year of profit at JPW.

After 8 years at JPW Racing Tipster and because of the success we had, I wanted a new challenge of finding the best tipsters within the industry. So many individuals have amazing knowledge of the sport of kings but most go unrecognised. I learned a lot over the 8 years and I wanted to nurture the next breed of successful tipsters. I set up www.tipsterempire.co.uk where we now have some of the best tipsters in the UK.

Since then we have also set up www.jpwscoop6.com where we tackle the Scoop 6 each Saturday as a Syndicate.

Would you say that you have a “typical” working day, and how would you describe it?

My typical working day Monday - Friday is around 12 hours. 7am - 8:30am from home and then take kids to School. I am then off to the office to work between 9:30am - 6:30pm. An hour or two at night working from home.

With 3 websites to run I have to be on the ball with a lot of tasks and follow a daily list.

Being organised is the key to making it work and I am committed to try and provide the best customer service within the industry.

What do you think of the world of sports tipping in general and what do you think people are in search of when it comes to their hunt for a successful tipster?

The world of sports tipping is a tough industry to work as a tipster.

You have to have a certain mental attitude and without the right frame of mind, most tipsters are defeated.

Honesty has served me well in the 12 years I have been going along with transparency in results. I am always open and honest and that has helped me build an excellent rapport with our customers.

Ultimately they know where they stand then with myself or any of our tipsters.

Do you regularly bet yourself? What style of approach do you take to your betting? What do you think of staking plans, loss retrieval systems etc.?

I find it hard these days to strike bets or even when I can the stakes are reduced.

If there is enough liquidity in the market on Betfair, I will get involved but most of the time my betting is done at the bigger festivals. I find my stakes are not reduced as much at festivals and also the liquidity on Betfair is much stronger with better racing.

I mainly bet to level stakes but on the rare occasion I may increase stakes if I am massively confident. Slow and steady is the way I have always worked.

What attracted you to the world of horse racing and what do you enjoy most about the sport?

My Grandfather was a massive Horse Racing fan and asked me to pick a horse in Grand National. He asked all his Grand Children to pick a horse and where others said I like that colour or that name; I asked what he looks at.

He explained how he read the form and I took the paper and studied the race, following his instructions. Sure enough I found the winner in the form of Earth Summit and well the rest is history, as the saying goes, I was hooked.

What led you into the world of racing tipsters and what do you feel you can offer racing enthusiasts and punters that other tipsters can't?

I can offer you a pick of many horse racing tipsters all who have a long term track record and results which is proofed and recorded over many years.

If it is not myself then we have another 6 tipsters.

We are as honest as they come and a limited company who pay taxes and VAT. If you want to reach us by telephone between 9am - 5pm then just ring the office phone.

Not many services out there run a smooth professional operation like ours and the team and you certainly can't just pick up the phone to most tipsters or platforms. The company is built on trust and honesty and as I said we thrive on Customer Service.

What traits do you think a good racing tipster should possess and what do you think the average punter is looking for from a tipping service?

As a Horse Racing Tipster you have to have confidence. I don't mean confidence in a cocky way but that self belief. The mind-set is also so important.

You will no doubt go on a losing run and I have seen many times, tipsters who struggle with the mind set through bad times.

You also need to have an instinct to spot value as this is a game between yourself and the trader. Find the mistakes consistently and the profits will soar.

Combine all the above with hard work and dedication and you will have a good racing tipster. I suppose an average punter wants to make profit but with so many cowboys in the tipping industry, they need to know they can trust you.

New and old punters alike can struggle to make a success of their betting. If you could give them just one piece of advice to improve their profitability what would it be?

Practice pricing up races and learn more about value betting.

As mentioned above it is you against the trader so a bit like a game of chess.

If you can master what the end user is doing (trader pricing up a race), you just need to be better than they are to find the value consistently.

Obviously you need a good work ethic and to be dedicated.

What would you consider to be a highlight of your racing experience to date? Do you have any personal racing / betting experiences which when reflecting back brings a smile, or for that matter any which bring a grimace; you can share with our readers?

My highlight and grimace could be combined into one.

I was having a terrible Cheltenham Festival, in fact the worst of my career back in 2011. All festival had been 2nds and 3rd and it is safe to say I was not in a good place.

The very last race was the Grand Annual and my E/W Nap of the festival was running in the form of Oiseau De Nuit. I think the evening before I had tipped him up at 25/1 as I made him a 14/1 shot. I could not believe my eyes that 2 minutes before the race he was 40/1 on course and a quick check on the Tote and he was 75.00.

I had my last £50 from my betting bank after losing a good few quid over 4 days and I raced over to the Tote, 30 seconds before the off and said £50 win.

That was something I would never do, £50 on the nose at the odds but given I had a horrific festival, and it wasn't the end of the world. I quickly got back to my dad and said this horse will win they have been up to something all season and now they have put a 7lb claimer on.

Classic Terry Warner plotting something here and had my eyes on it all week.

Sure enough he won by 4 lengths and when I went to collect he was 69.00 on the Tote.

It makes me grimace as that festival could have been terrible but it goes to show that you only need one winner at the Cheltenham Festival and you come away with big profits.

It truly is the place of dreams and what a cracking Gold Cup night we had after that.

What about the gambling industry, is there anything you like to see changed there? Many website forums are full of criticisms of the bookmakers and their treatment of their customers? Is this something you have an opinion on?

I would love to see tipping industry regulated.

So many wrong-uns in the industry who are basically con artists. They give genuine and honest companies like us, a bad name.

As long as bookmakers are allowed to get away with what they do then they will continue to treat customers how they want to.

I do think the FOBT (fixed odds betting terminals) has and will have a big effect on bookmakers so they will be much keener to take a bet if they are not making as much profit from FOBT.

Who knows though it has been a talking point for many years and it gets a bit boring.

What do you do to relax and unwind? What interests have you outside the world of horse racing?

I am a massive family man so other than Horse Racing you will find me with my kids and wife, mainly in our holiday home in Devon throughout the summer.





Trainers to follow in October

It's hard to believe that we are about to enter the final weeks of the 2019 flat season. It doesn't seem that long ago that we were looking forward to Newmarket's Craven Meeting and the first Classic trials of the season.

By the time you read this, the winter jumps season will be almost with us.

Chepstow hosts the first big jump meeting of the autumn with a two-day meeting on Friday 11th and Saturday 12th. It's a meeting where the likes of Cue Card, Silviniaco Conti and Finian's Oscar have made their seasonal returns in recent years.

At the end of month Cheltenham holds its first meeting of the 2019-20 jumps season.

The flat season is starting to wind down now, although there is still some top-class horse racing for us to look forward too.

Over the English Channel we have Arc Weekend at Longchamp.

At Newmarket we have the Dubai Future Champions Weekend which also includes the Dubai Cesarewitch Heritage Handicap, the second leg of the historic Autumn Double, after the Cambridgeshire.

A week later we have the end of season spectacular; Champions Day at Ascot.

The month ends with Britain's final Group 1 of the season the Vertem Futurity Trophy at Doncaster which is on the same day as the second day of Cheltenham's Showcase Meeting.

In this month's Acorns I'm looking at trainers who have been profitable to follow during October in recent years.

With the winter jumps season about to get underway I have included two NH trainers, there's also trainer on the flat and two on the all-weather.

As ever the excellent <http://www.horseracebase.com> with its mine of detailed information and stats is the starting point for this month's investigation.

To get a decent sample size and to keep the stats as relevant as possible, I have concentrated on trainers who have had at least 20 runners during the period under research and taken into consideration only their results from 2014.

Here is what I found during my research, beginning with the jumps.

National Hunt Trainers

The top six trainers ordered by winners are:

Looking at those stats the two trainers I'm drawn to are Paul Nicholls and Nigel Twiston-Davies. Both trainers have good win strike rates with their runners during the month and both have posted profits during the period under analysis.

Paul Nicholls

Paul Nicholls is winning with almost 1 in 3 of his runners during the month and almost half of them are placing.

Nicholls has an excellent win strike rate with his NHF runners, albeit he hasn't had many runners in the sphere.

It is important to remember that these bets are purely for the month of October and as such there maybe too many or indeed to few qualifiers for you, depending on your betting strategies.



Improving Your Punting – Part II

There's just one fundamental objective for punters and that to make a consistent profit. To achieve that objective doesn't necessarily depend on hours of form study or detailed assessment of each horse chance in the race. Most punters don't have the time or experience to undertake such tasks.

In the second part of this short series on improving your punting. I'm looking at the most profitable betting angles, involving last time out winners.

Last Time Winners: It's in the eye of the beholder.

When I began my betting journey, the first thing to catch my eye was seeing 1 or string of 1s in a horse's form figures. Yet the 1 is just a number and is meaningless out of context. For example: A win in Class 5 handicap is normally not better than a 5th in a Group 1 race.

But here's the conundrum, when you look at articles on last time out winners you will see some pundits say, "look out for last time out winners" and they should be the basis of a win betting strategy.

Whilst on the other side of the coin you will those say, "beware last time out winners" and they are a sound basis for a laying strategy.

So, who's is right?

Well both are. It's all down to interpretation and without that, the numbers are just numbers.

Using the ever reliable www.horseracebase.com here are my findings.

The win strike rate has risen to 50% and if you had backed all such qualifiers you would have made a decent £42.17 profit to a £1 stake.

Summary: Granted not large number of bets but the overall results show that these horses are being underestimated by the market and are definitely worthy of further consideration.

2. Last Time Out Winners By Trainer

When a horse wins a race it's the trainer's job to maintain the horses' peak mental / physical condition and to hopefully place the horse in the right race to win again. Some trainers are good at this and get follow up win from their horses, whilst others get the win and that's job done for now.

Since the start of 2017 there have been a few National Hunt trainers who are stand out in their placement of last time out winners, in terms of win strike rate and even more importantly profitability.

Here are the top NH trainers with last time out winners. All the trainers in the table below have had at least 50 qualifying runners.





The Trial: Gary Boswell has written for us on occasions in the past and also offers an advisory service entitled Bet Less Win More.

Covering a range of different sports including horse racing, tennis and football Gary emails mainly daily selections for a lay bet on short priced horses considered to be poor value and a back bet on another runner in the same race considered to be worthy of value given the odds on offer at the time.

Suggested stakes have ranged from 0.05-0.50 points so for example if your normal stake is £25.00 you would have staked between £1.25 – £12.50. Maximum odds for the lay selections and the back selections are advised.

Our first 14 days have provided 15 lay selections of which 10 were successful and 11 backing bets of which 2 were winners giving us a profit of just over 1.80 points for a total staked of 6.30 points.

Conclusion: This is possibly a slow and steady wins the race approach for the serious portfolio. [Find out more here.](#)

Cost: 14 day free trial then £29.99 per month / £79.99 quarterly / £299.99 yearly.

The Trial: In our last review we wrote that although we were almost 45 points down we just needed a winner to rectify things, we duly received a winning tip at ...45/1!

There have been tips for 3 tournaments since our last report: the WGC Fedex St Jude Invitational - all 6 tips offered were losers; on the Wyndham Championship 6 points were staked. Rory Sabbatini came close, being backed each-way for the first 5 places, and tying for 6th.

However the PGA Tour's the Northern Trust brought around a change of fortune when Patrick Reed backed 1-point each-way at 45/1 was the outright winner and Adam Scott was 5th at 40/1.

There were still further returns from the 1st Round Leader market with Webb Simpson and Tony Finau sharing the places.

The 9 points spread across the 5 tips returned a profit of 64.71 points. The balance sheet to date shows a small profit of almost 2 points to advised stakes and odds.

Conclusion: Waiting and hoping for a winner.
